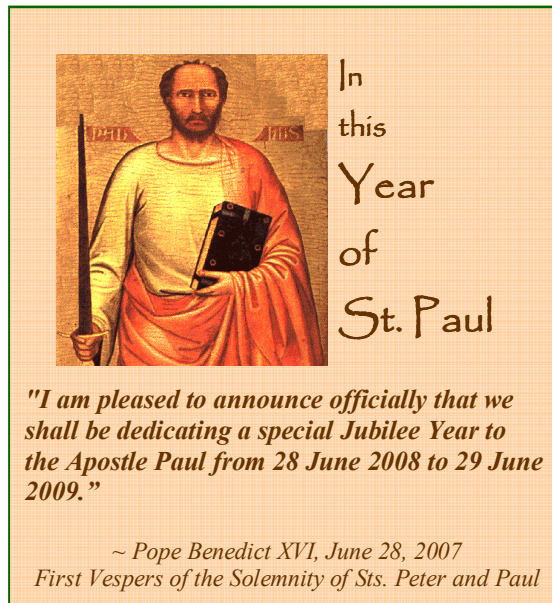

**WALK** through Ephesus, the most preserved archaeological site in Turkey where Paul stayed for 3 years.

**EXPLORE** remnants of Hellenistic, Roman, and Byzantine times in two of the cities of the Book of Revelation: Pergamum (Rev 2:12) and Sardis (Rev 3:1).

**SEE** the spectacular white lime cascades and hot springs of Pamukkale.

**VISIT** 6th century basilica, Hagia Sophia (Holy Wisdom), Chora monastery, the Blue Mosque and Topkapi Palace in Istanbul.

### Day One

### Day Three
